- 11. To discuss and take action on the imposition of early additional penalty for collection costs for taxes imposed on personal property on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.11 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.
- 12. To receive a report from the Huffman Fire and EMS Department.
- 13. To review, discuss and act on the acquisition and financing of new vehicles, equipment, and apparatus.
- 14. To review and approve expenditures required for the repair, maintenance and replacement of the District's real property, facilities, signage, vehicles, apparatus and equipment.
